Press Conference Announcing Community Mitigation Agreement between Palmetto Railways and Community Groups in North Charleston

NORTH CHARLESTON, SC - On November 9, 2016, at 11am local leaders from the Chicora Neighborhood Council, the Union Heights Neighborhood Council the Low Country Alliance for Model Communities (LAMC), and the Metanoia Community Development Corporation, along with Palmetto Railways will hold a press conference to announce an agreement to mitigate against the potential effects of the Navy Base Intermodal Facility to be constructed by Palmetto Railways on the former Charleston Navy Base.

The agreement represents months of dialogue and hard work between community leaders and the leadership of Palmetto Railways. Some of the benefits this agreement will provide to surrounding communities are job opportunities, environmental monitoring and funding for community projects in the Chicora/Cherokee and Union Heights communities. The agreement provides \$4 million to enhance these communities which surround the new facility. Additionally, more than half of the \$4 million will go toward constructing a new recreation facility to be constructed on land donated by the City of North Charleston on property behind the Military Magnet Academy in North Charleston. Remaining money will provide funding for initiatives in affordable housing, job training, educational initiatives, environmental research, community youth initiatives, and building the capacity of local organizations.

Community leaders and Palmetto Railways will be on hand to announce this agreement and answer questions at a media event scheduled for 11am on the morning of November 9. The press conference will be held at the corner of North Carolina and Reynolds Avenues in North Charleston. The event is open to the public and refreshments will be provided.
